

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT
Committee on Judiciary.

SB20-136 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 35, after line 14 insert:

2 **"SECTION 55.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-1-125, **amend**
3 (3)(b)(I) as follows:

4 **33-1-125. Colorado nongame conservation and wildlife**
5 **restoration cash fund - creation - disbursement of money - wildlife**
6 **rehabilitation grant program - authority and board created - process**
7 **- report - definitions.** (3) (b) (I) Except as provided in subsection
8 (3)(b)(II) of this section, Appointments to the board are for three-year
9 terms. Each member serves at the pleasure of the director and continues
10 in office until the member's successor is appointed and qualified. The
11 director shall make the initial appointments to the board no later than
12 September 1, 2017.

13 **SECTION 56.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-9-101, **amend**
14 (3)(e)(I); and **repeal** (3)(f) as follows:

15 **33-9-101. Commission - creation - composition - terms -**
16 **vacancies - removal - meetings - strategic plan - legislative**
17 **declaration.** (3) (e) (I) Except as provided in paragraph (f) of this
18 subsection (3), Terms of members serving pursuant to paragraph (b) of
19 subsection (2) SUBSECTION (2)(b) of this section are for four years.

20 (f) (I) Initial appointments of voting members of the commission
21 are as follows: Two members to serve until July 1, 2013; three members
22 to serve until July 18, 2014; three members to serve until July 18, 2015;
23 and three members to serve until July 18, 2016. All subsequent
24 appointments are for terms of four years.

25 (H) In making initial appointments to the commission under
26 subparagraph (I) of this paragraph (f), the governor may select persons
27 serving on the former parks and wildlife board, as that board existed on
28 June 30, 2012. However, a person so appointed is ineligible to serve any
29 of the initial appointments that would result in extending for more than
30 two years the date on which the person's parks and wildlife board term
31 would have expired.

32 **SECTION 57.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14-106, **amend**
33 (1) as follows:

34 **33-14-106. Snowmobile recreation fund - creation - use of**
35 **money.** (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS
36 SECTION, all fees from the registration of snowmobiles, all money
37 collected for fines under this article 14, and all interest earned on the fees
38 and fines shall be credited to the snowmobile recreation fund, hereby
39 created, and shall be used for the administration of this article 14 and for

1 the establishment and maintenance of snowmobile trails, vehicle parking
2 areas, and facilities. However, any fee money collected in excess of five
3 dollars per original or renewal registration shall be used exclusively for
4 direct services and not administrative costs.".

5 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
