

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

SB24-229 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 24, after line 25 insert:

2 **"SECTION 14. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2024-25 state fiscal
3 year, \$492,928 is appropriated to the department of public health and
4 environment. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement
5 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:

6 (a) \$75,846 for use by the air pollution control division for
7 personal services related to stationary sources, which amount is based on
8 an assumption that the division will require an additional 0.8 FTE;

9 (b) \$301,864 for use by the air pollution control division for
10 operating expenses related to stationary sources; and

11 (c) \$115,218 for the purchase of legal services.

12 (2) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$115,218 is appropriated to
13 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds
14 received from the department of public health and environment under
15 subsection (1)(c) of this section and is based on an assumption that the
16 department of law will require an additional 0.5 FTE. To implement this
17 act, the department of law may use this appropriation to provide legal
18 services for the department of public health and environment.

19 (3) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$179,127 is appropriated to
20 the department of natural resources for use by the energy and carbon
21 management commission. This appropriation is from the energy and
22 carbon management cash fund created in section 34-60-122 (5)(a),
23 C.R.S., and is based on an assumption that the commission will require
24 an additional 2.0 FTE. To implement this act, the commission may use
25 this appropriation for program costs."

26 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

27 Page 1, line 102, strike "STATE." and substitute "STATE, AND, IN
28 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
