

1 Amend the Transportation and Energy Committee Report, dated April 16,  
2 2019, page 2, strike line 1 and substitute:

3 "Page 2 of the reengrossed bill, strike line 3 and substitute "(2)(b)(I)(A),  
4 (2)(b)(II), and (5)(b)(I); and **add** (2)(b)(I)(D) and (3.5) as follows:".".

5 Page 2 of the committee report, line 19, strike ""**SECTION 3.**" and  
6 substitute:

7 **"(5) Purchases of the output from community solar gardens.**

8 (b) (I) (A) The output from a community solar garden shall be sold only  
9 to the qualifying retail utility serving the geographic area where the  
10 community solar garden is located.

11 (B) Once a community solar garden is part of a qualifying retail  
12 utility's plan for acquisition of renewable resources, as approved by the  
13 commission, THE COMMISSION SHALL BY JANUARY 30, 2020, INITIATE A  
14 PROCEEDING, OR CONSIDER IN AN ACTIVE PROCEEDING, TO DETERMINE  
15 WHETHER the qualifying retail utility shall purchase all of the electricity  
16 and renewable energy credits generated by the community solar garden  
17 OR WHETHER A SUBSCRIBER MAY, UPON BECOMING A SUBSCRIBER, CHOOSE  
18 TO RETAIN OR SELL TO THE QUALIFYING RETAIL UTILITY THE SUBSCRIBER'S  
19 RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS.

20 (C) The amount of electricity and renewable energy credits  
21 generated by each community solar garden shall be determined by a  
22 production meter installed by the qualifying retail utility or third-party  
23 system owner and paid for by the owner of the community solar garden.
