## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend the Public and Behavioral Health and Human Services Committee  
2 Report, dated February 7, 2023, page 3, strike lines 21 through 28 and  
3 substitute:

4 "Page 7, strike lines 13 through 22 and substitute "SCREENER SHALL NOT  
5 DISCLOSE RECORDS OR INFORMATION WITHOUT WRITTEN CONSENT FROM  
6 THE STUDENT, IF THE STUDENT IS OVER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE; THE  
7 STUDENT, IF THE STUDENT IS TWELVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER BUT UNDER  
8 EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, CONSENTS ON THE STUDENT'S OWN BEHALF TO  
9 PARTICIPATE IN THE SCREENING, AND DOES NOT CONSENT TO PARENTAL  
10 NOTIFICATION; OR THE STUDENT'S PARENT. A PARENT OF A STUDENT WHO  
11 CONSENTS FOR THE STUDENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SCREENING ON THE  
12 STUDENT'S BEHALF CANNOT PROVIDE WRITTEN CONSENT FOR THE  
13 DISCLOSURE OF THOSE RECORDS WITHOUT THE STUDENT'S CONSENT. ALL  
14 PARTIES SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY  
15 WITH ALL APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL "AMERICANS WITH  
16 DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990", 42 U.S.C. SEC. 12101, ET SEQ., AS AMENDED;  
17 SECTION 504 OF THE FEDERAL "REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973, 29 U.S.C.  
18 SEC. 794, AS AMENDED; AND TITLE VI OF THE FEDERAL "CIVIL RIGHTS  
19 ACT OF 1964", AS AMENDED.".".
