

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Appropriations.

SB22-206 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 25, before line 23 insert:

2       **"SECTION 5. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal  
3 year, \$472,137 is appropriated to the office of the governor. This  
4 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
5 department may use this appropriation as follows:

6           (a) \$426,629 for use by the office of the governor for the office  
7 of climate preparedness related to governor's office, which amount is  
8 based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 2.7 FTE;

9           (b) \$30,722 for use by the Colorado energy office related to  
10 sustainable building program; and

11           (c) \$14,786 for the purchase of legal services related to the  
12 Colorado energy office.

13       (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$14,786 is appropriated to  
14 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
15 received from the office of the governor under subsection (1)(c) of this  
16 section. To implement this act, the department of law may use this  
17 appropriation to provide legal services for the Colorado energy office.

18       (3) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$233,837 is appropriated to  
19 the department of local affairs. This appropriation is from the general  
20 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
21 as follows:

22           (a) \$219,052 for use by the division of local government for  
23 disaster resilience rebuilding program related to community services,  
24 which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an  
25 additional 2.8 FTE; and

26           (b) \$14,785 for the purchase of legal services.

27       (4) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$14,785 is appropriated to  
28 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
29 received from the department of local affairs under subsection (1)(b) of  
30 this section. To implement this act, the department of law may use this  
31 appropriation to provide legal services for the department of local affairs.

32       (5) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$91,937 is appropriated to the  
33 department of agriculture for use by the agricultural services division.  
34 This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption  
35 that the division will require an additional 0.9 FTE. To implement this  
36 act, the division may use this appropriation for the conservation services  
37 division.

38       (6) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$107,307 is appropriated to  
39 the department of natural resources for use by the division of parks and  
40 wildlife. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an

1 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.9 FTE. To  
2 implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for wildlife  
3 operations.

4 (7) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$19,334 is appropriated to  
5 the department of personnel for use by the division of capital assets. This  
6 appropriation is from the Colorado firefighting air corps fund created in  
7 section 24-33.5-1228 (3)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the division  
8 may use this appropriation for vehicle replacement lease/purchase for the  
9 department of public safety.

10 (8) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$230,000 is appropriated to  
11 the department of regulatory agencies for use by the division of insurance.  
12 This appropriation is from the division of insurance cash fund created in  
13 section 10-1-103 (3), C.R.S. To implement this act, the division may use  
14 this appropriation for personal services."

15 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

16 Page 1, line 104, strike "AND".

17 Page 1, line 105, strike "PREPAREDNESS." AND SUBSTITUTE  
18 "PREPAREDNESS, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."
