

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Veterans, & Military Affairs.

SB22-206 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 23, strike lines 25 through 27.
- 2 Page 24, strike lines 1 and 2 and substitute "OFFICE. THE OFFICE SHALL:  
3 (I) COORDINATE DISASTER RECOVERY EFFORTS FOR THE  
4 GOVERNOR'S OFFICE, AS DETERMINED BY THE GOVERNOR AND CONSISTENT  
5 WITH SECTIONS 24-33.5-704 (6.5) AND 24-33.5-705.2, SEEKING TO  
6 INTEGRATE CLIMATE RESILIENCE AND ADAPTATION INTO RECOVERY  
7 EFFORTS; AND  
8 (II) DEVELOP, PUBLISH, AND IMPLEMENT THE STATEWIDE CLIMATE  
9 PREPAREDNESS ROADMAP REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-38.8-103  
10 (1).".
- 11 Page 24, line 4, strike "GROUPS" and substitute "GROUPS, WITH  
12 PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO THE INCLUSION, ACCESSIBILITY, AND  
13 ENGAGEMENT OF DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITIES, AS  
14 DEFINED IN SECTION 24-4-109 (2)(b)(II),".
- 15 Page 24, line 10, strike "ROADMAP" and substitute "ROADMAP, INCLUDING  
16 ALL SUBSEQUENT UPDATES,".
- 17 Page 24, line 20, strike "RECOVERY." and substitute "RECOVERY,  
18 INCLUDING NEW OR UPDATED PLANS COMPLETED AFTER THE INITIAL  
19 PUBLICATION OF THE ROADMAP.".
- 20 Page 25, line 4, after "DEVELOPMENT," insert "WATER QUALITY AND  
21 QUANTITY,".
- 22 Page 25, line 17, strike "COMMUNITIES;" and substitute "COMMUNITIES IN  
23 COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY CREATED IN  
24 SECTION 24-33.5-103, THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS CREATED IN  
25 SECTION 24-1-125, AND THE COLORADO RESILIENCY OFFICE CREATED IN  
26 SECTION 24-32-122;".
- 27 Page 25, line 18, strike "ACKNOWLEDGES THAT CERTAIN COMMUNITIES"  
28 and substitute "ACTIVELY TAKES INTO ACCOUNT THAT  
29 DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITIES, AS DEFINED IN SECTION  
30 24-4-109 (2)(b)(II),".
