

SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Health & Human Services.

SB25-194 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 16, line 9, after "(t)" insert "(I)".

2 Page 16, strike lines 11 through 15 and substitute "DENTAL BOARD,
3 ORDERS AND ADMINISTERS IMMUNIZATIONS TO PATIENTS SIX YEARS OF
4 AGE OR OLDER. THE COLORADO DENTAL BOARD SHALL ADOPT RULES".

5 Page 16, after line 17 insert:

6 "(II) DENTISTS AND DENTAL HYGIENISTS:

7 (A) ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE MEDICAL EXEMPTIONS FOR
8 ANY REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS;

9 (B) SHALL ENTER ALL IMMUNIZATION-RELATED ADMINISTRATION
10 INFORMATION INTO THE COLORADO IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION SYSTEM
11 CREATED PURSUANT TO PART 24 OF ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 25; AND

12 (C) WHO ADMINISTER IMMUNIZATIONS SHALL DISCLOSE THEIR
13 MEDICAL TRAINING RELATED TO PEDIATRIC ADMINISTRATION, INCLUDING
14 THE ABILITY TO MANAGE SIDE EFFECTS OR ADVERSE OUTCOMES, TO
15 PATIENTS AS PART OF THE PATIENT CONSENT PROCESS."

16 Page 24, after line 3 insert:

17 "SECTION 20. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-220-411,
18 amend (1) and (5)(a) as follows:

19 **12-220-411. Anesthesia and sedation permits - dentists, dental**
20 **therapists, and dental hygienists - training and experience**
21 **requirements - office inspections - rules.** (1) (a) Upon application in a
22 form and manner determined by the board and payment of the applicable
23 fees established by the board, the board may issue an anesthesia or
24 sedation permit to a licensed dentist or a local anesthesia permit to a
25 dental therapist or dental hygienist in accordance with this section.

26 (b) THE BOARD SHALL DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT AN EXPEDITED
27 APPLICATION AND PERMITTING PROCESS FOR A DENTIST WHO HAS
28 COMPLETED AN ACCREDITED RESIDENCY PROGRAM IN GENERAL
29 ANESTHESIA OR A POSTDOCTORAL TRAINING PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES
30 COMPREHENSIVE AND APPROPRIATE TRAINING NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER
31 AND MANAGE MODERATE SEDATION OR DEEP SEDATION AND GENERAL
32 ANESTHESIA ACCORDING TO INDUSTRY-ACCEPTED STANDARDS.

33 (5) The board shall establish, by rule, criteria and procedures for
34 an office inspection program to be completed upon application and
35 renewal of anesthesia or sedation permits, which must include:

36 (a) Designation of qualified ANESTHESIA inspectors who ~~are~~
37 ~~experts in dental outpatient deep sedation/general anesthesia and~~
38 ~~moderate sedation~~; HAVE MORE THAN FIVE YEARS OF EXPERIENCE

1 PROVIDING ANESTHESIA SERVICES AND HOLD AN ACTIVE ANESTHESIA
2 PERMIT TO PROVIDE EITHER DENTAL OUTPATIENT DEEP
3 SEDATION/GENERAL ANESTHESIA OR MODERATE SEDATION. AN
4 ANESTHESIA INSPECTOR WHO HOLDS AN ACTIVE ANESTHESIA PERMIT TO
5 PROVIDE MODERATE SEDATION MAY ONLY PROVIDE OFFICE ANESTHESIA
6 INSPECTIONS FOR PROVIDERS WHO REQUEST MODERATE SEDATION
7 PRIVILEGES FOR BOTH INITIAL AND RENEWAL PERMIT APPLICATIONS. AN
8 ANESTHESIA INSPECTOR WHO HOLDS AN ACTIVE ANESTHESIA PERMIT TO
9 PROVIDE DEEP SEDATION/GENERAL ANESTHESIA MAY PROVIDE OFFICE
10 ANESTHESIA INSPECTIONS FOR ANY LEVEL OF SEDATION FOR BOTH INITIAL
11 AND RENEWAL PERMIT APPLICATIONS. AN ANESTHESIA INSPECTOR SHALL
12 COMPLETE AN ANESTHESIA INSPECTOR CALIBRATION PROGRAM CREATED
13 AND UPDATED BY THE BOARD ONCE EVERY FIVE YEARS. THE ANESTHESIA
14 INSPECTOR RECERTIFICATION MAY BE COMPLETED IN CONJUNCTION WITH
15 AN ANESTHESIA PERMIT RENEWAL."
