

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.

HB22-1131 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 7, after line 21 insert:
2 "SECTION 9. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 19-2.5-302, **amend**
3 (1) as follows:
4 **19-2.5-302. Local juvenile services planning committee -**
5 **creation - duties - identification and notification of dually identified**
6 **crossover youth.** (1) If all of the boards of commissioners of each
7 county or the city council of each city and county in a judicial district
8 agree, there may be created in the judicial district a local juvenile services
9 planning committee that is appointed by the chief judge of the judicial
10 district or, for the second judicial district, the presiding judge of the
11 Denver juvenile court, from persons recommended by the boards of
12 commissioners of each county or the city council of each city and county
13 within the judicial district. The committee, if practicable, must include,
14 but need not be limited to, a representative from a county department of
15 human or social services, a local school district, a local law enforcement
16 agency, a local probation department, the division of youth services,
17 private citizens, the district attorney's office, the public defender's office,
18 a community mental health representative, and a representative of the
19 concerns of municipalities. The committee, if created, shall meet as
20 necessary to develop a plan for the allocation of resources for local
21 juvenile services within the judicial district for the fiscal year. The
22 committee is strongly encouraged to consider programs with restorative
23 justice components when developing the plan. ADDITIONALLY, THE
24 COMMITTEE IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO
25 CHILDREN WHO ARE TEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER BUT UNDER THIRTEEN
26 YEARS OF AGE WHO ARE AT RISK OF ENTERING DETENTION AT AN OLDER
27 AGE IF THEY DO NOT RECEIVE ALTERNATIVE SERVICES AS A PART OF THE
28 PLAN. The state department of human services shall approve the plan. A
29 local juvenile services planning committee may be consolidated with
30 other local advisory boards pursuant to section 24-1.7-103."
- 31 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 32 Page 13, strike lines 5 and 6, and substitute "**amend** (1)(b)(V) as
33 follows:".
- 34 Page 13, strike lines 23 through 27.
- 35 Page 14, strike lines 1 through 16.
- 36 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

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
