Committee on Appropriations.

SB19-228 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 6, strike lines 14 through 26.
- 2 Rerumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 3 Page 9, strike lines 13 through 27.
- 4 Strike pages 10 and 11.
- 5 Page 12, strike lines 1 through 14 and substitute:
 - 6 **"SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 27-80-106, **add (3)** as follows:
 - 8 **27-80-106. Purchase of prevention and treatment services.**
 - 9 (3) (a) THERE IS CREATED IN THE OFFICE OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH,
10 REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION AS THE "OFFICE", THE CHARLIE HUGHES
11 AND NATHAN GAUNA OPIOID PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM TO IMPROVE
12 YOUNG LIVES, REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION AS THE "PROGRAM", FOR
13 PREVENTING OPIOID USE AMONG THE STATE'S YOUTH POPULATION.
 - 14 (b) THE OFFICE SHALL, IN COORDINATION WITH THE STATE PLAN
15 FORMULATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 27-80-102, PURCHASE PREVENTION
16 SERVICES FROM ONE OR MORE COMMUNITY-BASED YOUTH DEVELOPMENT
17 ORGANIZATIONS THAT ADMINISTER EVIDENCE-BASED SUBSTANCE USE
18 PREVENTION PROGRAMS TO YOUTH AND FAMILIES. THE OFFICE SHALL
19 PRIORITIZE THE AMOUNTS OF FUNDING REQUESTED IN THEIR ENTIRETY OR
20 IN AMOUNTS SUFFICIENT TO ENSURE THAT GRANT RECIPIENTS ARE ABLE TO
21 FULLY OR SUBSTANTIALLY IMPLEMENT PROGRAMS TO FIDELITY. THE
22 OFFICE MAY USE UP TO TEN PERCENT OF THE MONEY APPROPRIATED TO
23 THE PROGRAM FOR ADMINISTRATION AND EVALUATION OF THE
24 PROGRAM.".

5 **27-80-119. Perinatal substance use data linkage project -**
6 **center for research into substance use disorder prevention,**
7 **treatment, and recovery support strategies - report.** (1) THE CENTER
8 FOR RESEARCH INTO SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER PREVENTION, TREATMENT,
9 AND RECOVERY SUPPORT STRATEGIES ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 27-80-118,
10 REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION AS THE "CENTER", IN PARTNERSHIP WITH AN
11 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE STATE SUBSTANCE ABUSE
12 TREND AND RESPONSE TASK FORCE ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 18-18.5-103,
13 MAY CONDUCT A STATEWIDE PERINATAL SUBSTANCE USE DATA LINKAGE
14 PROJECT THAT USES ONGOING COLLECTION, ANALYSIS, INTERPRETATION,
15 AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA FOR THE PLANNING, IMPLEMENTATION, AND
16 EVALUATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH ACTIONS TO IMPROVE OUTCOMES FOR
17 FAMILIES IMPACTED BY SUBSTANCE USE DURING PREGNANCY. THE DATA
18 LINKAGE PROJECT MAY CONSIDER STATE-ADMINISTERED DATA SOURCES
19 THAT INCLUDE:

20 (a) HEALTH CARE UTILIZATION BY PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM
21 WOMEN WITH SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS AND THEIR INFANTS;

22 (b) HUMAN SERVICE AND PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAM UTILIZATION
23 BY PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM WOMEN WITH SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS
24 AND THEIR INFANTS;

25 (c) HEALTH CARE, HUMAN SERVICE, AND PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAM
26 OUTCOMES AMONG PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM WOMEN WITH
27 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS AND THEIR INFANTS; AND

28 (d) COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH HEALTH CARE, HUMAN SERVICE, AND
29 PUBLIC HEALTH PROGRAM PROVISION FOR PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM
30 WOMEN WITH SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS AND THEIR INFANTS.

31 (2) THE DATA LINKAGE PROJECT SHALL USE VITAL RECORDS TO
32 ESTABLISH MATERNAL AND INFANT DYADS BEGINNING AT THE BIRTH
33 HOSPITALIZATION AND RETROSPECTIVELY LINK THE PRENATAL PERIOD
34 AND PROSPECTIVELY LINK THE FIRST YEAR POSTPARTUM.

35 (3) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY WILL
36 OBTAIN DATA AND PERFORM SECURE LINKAGE AND ANONYMIZATION ON
37 BEHALF OF THE STATE.

38 (4) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2021, THE CENTER SHALL REPORT
39 PROGRESS ON THE DATA LINKAGE PROJECT AND THE RESULTS, IF
40 AVAILABLE, TO THE HEALTH AND INSURANCE COMMITTEE AND THE PUBLIC
41 HEALTH CARE AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF

1 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE
2 OF THE SENATE OR THEIR SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES.".

3 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
