

SB19-172 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike lines 7 through 14 and substitute:

2 **"SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 17-18-127 as
3 follows:

4 **17-18-127. Appropriation to comply with section 2-2-703 - S.B.**
5 **19-172 - repeal.** (1) PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-2-703, THE FOLLOWING
6 STATUTORY APPROPRIATIONS ARE MADE IN ORDER TO IMPLEMENT SENATE
7 BILL 19-172, ENACTED IN 2019:

8 (a) FOR THE 2019-20 STATE FISCAL YEAR, ONE HUNDRED TEN
9 THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS IS APPROPRIATED FROM
10 THE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-75-302 TO THE
11 CORRECTIONS EXPANSION RESERVE FUND CREATED IN SECTION 17-1-116.

12 (b) FOR THE 2020-21 STATE FISCAL YEAR, TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND
13 TWO HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS IS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT
14 FROM THE GENERAL FUND.

15 (c) FOR THE 2021-22 STATE FISCAL YEAR, ONE THOUSAND NINE
16 HUNDRED TWO DOLLARS IS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT FROM THE
17 GENERAL FUND.

18 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-302, **add**
19 (2)(gg) as follows:

20 **24-75-302. Capital construction fund - capital assessment fees**
21 **- calculation - information technology capital account - repeal.**

22 (2) The controller shall transfer a sum as specified in this subsection (2)
23 from the general fund to the capital construction fund as money becomes
24 available in the general fund during the fiscal year beginning on July 1 of
25 the fiscal year in which the transfer is made. Transfers between funds
26 pursuant to this subsection (2) are not appropriations subject to the
27 limitations of section 24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to
28 this subsection (2) are as follows:

29 (gg) FOR THE 2019-20 STATE FISCAL YEAR, ONE HUNDRED TEN
30 THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS PURSUANT TO S.B. 19-172,
31 ENACTED IN 2019.".

32 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

33 Page 1, line 103, strike "**CONFINEMENT.**" and substitute "**CONFINEMENT**
34 **AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".
