 21 transfer \$108,357,699 from the marijuana tax cash fund created in
 22 section 39-28.8-501 to the the state education fund created in section 17
 23 (4)(a) of article IX of the state constitution, so that this money may be
 24 used to provide services for adolescents and school-aged children in
 25 school settings consistent with section 39-28.8-501.".

PURPOSE: Eliminates all appropriations from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund to departments other than the Department of Education. Reduces funding for **multiple departments** by a total of \$108.4 million. Adds a provision stating the General Assembly's intent to enact legislation to transfer \$108.4 million from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund to the State Education Fund.
