2 CONCERNING THE" and substitute "INCLUDING:

3 (I) INFORMATION CONCERNING THE POTENTIAL BENEFITS AND
4 RISKS OF DRY NEEDLING; AND

5 (II) A STATEMENT THAT THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST
6 PERFORMING DRY NEEDLING IS NOT AN ACUPUNCTURIST."

7 Page 2, strike line 16.

8 Page 2, line 20, after the period insert "AT A MINIMUM, THE RULES MUST
9 ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS THAT ARE EQUIVALENT TO THE REQUIREMENTS
10 ESTABLISHED IN RULES ADOPTED BY THE STATE PHYSICAL THERAPY BOARD
11 PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-285-116 (5)(b) AUTHORIZING A PHYSICAL
12 THERAPIST TO PERFORM DRY NEEDLING."
