1 Amend printed bill, page 10, after line 16 insert:

2 "SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-2-302.5, **add** (1.5)
3 as follows:

4 **1-2-302.5. Change of address search - rules.**

5 (1.5) (a) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1.5)(b) OF THIS
6 SECTION, IN ADDITION TO THE MONTHLY CHANGE OF ADDRESS SEARCH
7 CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, ON OR
8 BEFORE JUNE 1, 2027, AND ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1 IN EACH ODD-NUMBERED
9 YEAR THEREAFTER, AND ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2028, AND ON OR
10 BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 IN EACH EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
11 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CAUSE TO BE CONDUCTED AN ANNUAL
12 CHANGE OF ADDRESS SEARCH FOR ALL ELECTORS WHOSE NAMES APPEAR
13 IN THE STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION LIST BY TRANSMITTING ONLY THE
14 FOLLOWING VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR EACH ELECTOR TO
15 A THIRD-PARTY CREDIT BUREAU FOR ADDRESS VERIFICATION IN
16 ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION (1.5):

17 (I) FIRST AND LAST NAME;

18 (II) BIRTH YEAR; AND

19 (III) RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS.

20 (b) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT TRANSMIT, PURSUANT TO
21 SUBSECTION (1.5)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE VOTER REGISTRATION
22 INFORMATION FOR THE FOLLOWING ELECTORS WHOSE NAMES APPEAR IN
23 THE STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION LIST:

24 (I) ELECTORS WHO ARE PARTICIPANTS IN THE ADDRESS
25 CONFIDENTIALITY PROGRAM CREATED IN PART 21 OF ARTICLE 30 OF TITLE
26 24; AND

27 (II) ELECTORS, INCLUDING FIRST RESPONDERS, WHO HAVE
28 ENROLLED AS CONFIDENTIAL VOTERS PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-72-204
29 (3.5).

30 (c) PRIOR TO THE TRANSMISSION OF ANY VOTER REGISTRATION
31 INFORMATION PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1.5)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE
32 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
33 THIRD-PARTY CREDIT BUREAU IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE
34 "PROCUREMENT CODE", ARTICLES 101 TO 112 OF TITLE 24, AND THAT:

35 (I) ACKNOWLEDGES AND COMPLIES WITH THE TECHNOLOGICAL
36 SECURITY MEASURES DEVELOPED PURSUANT TO SECTION 1-2-302 (8) TO
37 PREVENT UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS TO THE COMPUTERIZED STATEWIDE
38 VOTER REGISTRATION LIST;

39 (II) ACKNOWLEDGES AND COMPLIES WITH THE TECHNOLOGICAL
40 SECURITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EXCHANGE OR TRANSFER OF DATA

1 RELATED TO VOTER REGISTRATION BETWEEN THE SECRETARY OF STATE
2 AND ANY OTHER AGENCY ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 1-2-302 (8)
3 AS IF THE CREDIT BUREAU IS SUCH AN AGENCY;

4 (III) PROVIDES THAT, NOT MORE THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE
5 RECEIPT OF THE VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION SPECIFIED IN
6 SUBSECTION (1.5)(a) OF THIS SECTION, THE THIRD-PARTY CREDIT BUREAU
7 SHALL COMPARE THE VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION TO THE NAME,
8 BIRTH YEAR, AND ADDRESS INFORMATION IN THE THIRD-PARTY CREDIT
9 BUREAU'S DATABASE AND IDENTIFY ANY DISCREPANCY IN THE ADDRESS
10 INFORMATION OF AN ELECTOR;

11 (IV) PROVIDES THAT, NOT MORE THAN THIRTY DAYS AFTER
12 COMPLETING THE COMPARISON REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1.5)(c)(III) OF
13 THIS SECTION, THE THIRD-PARTY CREDIT BUREAU SHALL CREATE AND
14 TRANSMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE A LIST OF ALL ELECTORS WITH A
15 DISCREPANCY IN THEIR ADDRESS INFORMATION, INCLUDING THE ADDRESS
16 INFORMATION FOR EACH ELECTOR FROM THE THIRD-PARTY CREDIT
17 BUREAU'S DATABASE; AND

18 (V) PROHIBITS THE THIRD-PARTY CREDIT BUREAU FROM SELLING,
19 DISCLOSING, OR OTHERWISE RELEASING THE VOTER REGISTRATION
20 INFORMATION TRANSMITTED FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO THE
21 THIRD-PARTY CREDIT BUREAU.

22 (d) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSMIT ANNUALLY TO THE
23 APPROPRIATE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER THE DATA OBTAINED FROM
24 THE SEARCH CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (1.5) FOR THE PURPOSE
25 OF IDENTIFYING POTENTIAL DISCREPANCIES IN ELECTOR ADDRESS
26 INFORMATION. SUCH DATA SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE DETERMINATIVE
27 PROOF OF AN ELECTOR'S ADDRESS OR REQUIRE A COUNTY CLERK AND
28 RECORDER TO CHANGE TO AN ELECTOR'S VOTER REGISTRATION
29 INFORMATION.

30 (e) EACH COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER SHALL REVIEW THE DATA
31 TRANSMITTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1.5)(d) OF THIS SECTION AND
32 TAKE ACTION AS NECESSARY, IN THEIR DISCRETION, TO RESOLVE IN
33 ACCORDANCE WITH EXISTING LAW, ANY DISCREPANCIES IN ELECTOR
34 ADDRESS INFORMATION THAT ARE PRESENTED BY THE DATA. THIS
35 SUBSECTION (1.5) DOES NOT CREATE ANY NEW DUTY, OBLIGATION, OR
36 RESPONSIBILITY FOR A COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER BEYOND THOSE
37 OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.

38 (f) THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY ESTABLISH RULES NECESSARY
39 TO IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THIS SUBSECTION (1.5).

40 (g) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION (1.5) SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO
41 ALTER, SUPERSEDE, OR OTHERWISE AFFECT COMPLIANCE WITH THE
42 FEDERAL "NATIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION ACT OF 1993", 52 U.S.C. SEC.
43 20501 ET SEQ., OR VOTER REGISTRATION RECORD MAINTENANCE
