1 Amend the State, Civic, Military, & Veterans Affairs Committee Report,
2 dated March 2, 2026, page 1, after line 3 insert:

3 "Page 3 of the bill, line 18, after "(1)(a)," insert "(2)(d),".

4 Page 3 of the bill, after line 24 insert:

5 "(2) (d) The firearm dealer permit cash fund is created in the state
6 treasury. The fund consists of money credited to the fund pursuant to
7 subsection (2)(c) of this section and any other money that the general
8 assembly may appropriate or transfer to the fund. The state treasurer shall
9 credit all interest and income derived from the deposit and investment of
10 money in the firearm dealer permit cash fund to the fund. Money in the
11 fund is continuously appropriated to the department for the costs of
12 issuing permits and conducting inspections pursuant to this section AND
13 AWARDING ASSISTANCE GRANTS PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2.5)(b)(II) OF
14 THIS SECTION."."

15 Page 1 of the report, line 16, strike "(2.5)(b)" and substitute "(2.5)(c)".

16 Page 1 of the report, after line 22 insert:

17 "(b) (I) BEFORE ENFORCING A NEW SECURITY MEASURES REQUIRED
18 IN THE DEPARTMENT'S RULES, THE DEPARTMENT MUST PREPARE AND
19 PUBLISH ON A PUBLICLY AVAILABLE PAGE OF ITS WEBSITE A SMALL
20 BUSINESS IMPACT ANALYSIS OF THE NEW REQUIREMENT THAT ESTIMATES
21 THE COST OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENT.

22 (II) IF, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT
23 ANALYSIS, THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT COMPLIANCE COSTS FOR
24 A SPECIFIC SECURITY REQUIREMENT EXCEED FIVE PERCENT OF PRIOR-YEAR
25 GROSS REVENUE OF A STATE PERMIT HOLDER WHO OPERATES A SMALL
26 BUSINESS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOW THE STATE PERMIT HOLDER A
27 PHASED COMPLIANCE PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN TWENTY-FOUR MONTHS
28 FOR THE SECURITY REQUIREMENT OR AWARD THE STATE PERMIT HOLDER
29 AN ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE FIREARM DEALER PERMIT CASH FUND TO
30 SUPPORT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SECURITY REQUIREMENT. THE
31 DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT POLICIES FOR STATE PERMIT HOLDERS TO
32 APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE GRANTS AND FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO REVIEW
33 APPLICATIONS AND AWARD GRANTS. THE POLICIES MUST INCLUDE
34 CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING WHETHER AN APPLICANT OPERATES A SMALL
35 BUSINESS."."

36 Page 1 of the report, line 23, strike "(b)" and substitute "(c)".

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
