

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 8, line 18, strike "(1)" and substitute "(1),
2 (2),".

3 Page 9, after line 2 add:

4 "(2) A person who files a malicious or knowingly false petition
5 for a temporary extreme risk protection order or an extreme risk
6 protection order may be subject to criminal prosecution or civil liability
7 for those acts. IN A CIVIL ACTION ARISING FROM A MALICIOUS OR
8 KNOWINGLY FALSE PETITION, A PREVAILING PLAINTIFF IS ENTITLED TO
9 ACTUAL DAMAGES AND ATTORNEY FEES AND COSTS, INCLUDING
10 ATTORNEY FEES AND COSTS INCURRED FROM DEFENDING THEMSELVES FROM
11 THE ORIGINAL TEMPORARY EXTREME RISK PROTECTION ORDER OR
12 EXTREME RISK PROTECTION ORDER."
