Committee on Health & Human Services.

HB26-1324 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, lines 5 and 6, strike "(4) by certified mail OR
2 EMAIL." and substitute "(4). ~~by certified mail~~".

3 Page 12, line 14, strike "**Excise tax on renewal**" and substitute
4 "**Renewal**".

5 Page 12, line 17, strike "excise tax" and substitute "~~excise tax~~
6 ADDITIONAL FEE".

7 Page 12, line 22, strike "excise tax" and substitute "~~excise tax~~
8 ADDITIONAL FEE".

9 Page 12, after line 23 insert:

10 "SECTION 24. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-20-105, amend
11 (5)(a) as follows:

12 **12-20-105. Fee adjustments - division of professions and**
13 **occupations cash fund created - legal defense account created -**
14 **general fund transfer - definition - repeal.**

15 (5) (a) The ~~excise tax~~ FEE collected pursuant to section 12-20-104
16 shall be credited to the legal defense account, which account is hereby
17 created within the division of professions and occupations cash fund. The
18 ~~excise tax~~ FEE is the sole source of funding for the account, and no other
19 fee or portion of a fee collected by a regulator and credited to the division
20 of professions and occupations cash fund shall be deposited in or
21 transferred to the account. The account shall be used to supplement
22 ~~revenues~~ REVENUE received by the division but shall only be used for the
23 purpose of paying legal expenses incurred by a regulator. Upon a
24 determination of the need of a regulator for additional ~~revenues~~ REVENUE
25 for the payment of legal expenses, the director may authorize the
26 allocation of ~~revenues~~ REVENUE from the legal defense account to a
27 regulator for legal expenses.

30 **12-120-211. Qualifications for engineer-interns.**

31 (1) (a) AN APPLICANT MAY QUALIFY FOR ENROLLMENT AS AN
32 ENGINEER-INTERN BY ENDORSEMENT IF THE APPLICANT IS ENROLLED IN
33 GOOD STANDING IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION REQUIRING QUALIFICATIONS
34 SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THOSE CURRENTLY REQUIRED OF
35 APPLICANTS UNDER THIS PART 2 OR IF, AT THE TIME OF INITIAL

1 ENROLLMENT IN THE OTHER JURISDICTION, THE APPLICANT MET THE
2 REQUIREMENTS FOR ENROLLMENT THEN IN EXISTENCE UNDER COLORADO
3 LAW.

4 (b) UPON COMPLETION OF THE APPLICATION AND APPROVAL BY
5 THE BOARD, AN APPLICANT QUALIFIED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a)
6 OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE ENROLLED AS AN ENGINEER-INTERM IF THE
7 APPLICANT IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-120-210.

8 **SECTION 26.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-120-213,
9 **recreate and reenact, with amendments,** (1) as follows:

10 **12-120-213. Qualifications for professional engineer.**

11 (1) (a) AN APPLICANT MAY QUALIFY FOR LICENSING AS A
12 PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER BY ENDORSEMENT IF THE APPLICANT IS LICENSED
13 IN GOOD STANDING IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION REQUIRING QUALIFICATIONS
14 SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THOSE CURRENTLY REQUIRED OF
15 APPLICANTS UNDER THIS PART 2 OR IF, AT THE TIME OF INITIAL LICENSURE
16 IN THE OTHER JURISDICTION, THE APPLICANT MET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
17 LICENSURE THEN IN EXISTENCE UNDER COLORADO LAW.

18 (b) UPON COMPLETION OF THE APPLICATION AND APPROVAL BY

35 (1) (a) AN APPLICANT MAY QUALIFY FOR ENROLLMENT AS A LAND
36 SURVEYOR-INTERM BY ENDORSEMENT IF THE APPLICANT IS ENROLLED IN
37 GOOD STANDING IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION REQUIRING QUALIFICATIONS
38 SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THOSE CURRENTLY REQUIRED OF
39 APPLICANTS UNDER THIS PART 3 OR IF, AT THE TIME OF INITIAL
40 ENROLLMENT IN THE OTHER JURISDICTION, THE APPLICANT MET THE
41 REQUIREMENTS FOR ENROLLMENT THEN IN EXISTENCE UNDER COLORADO
42 LAW.

43 (b) UPON COMPLETION OF THE APPLICATION AND APPROVAL BY
44 THE BOARD, AN APPLICANT QUALIFIED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a)
45 OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE ENROLLED AS A LAND SURVEYOR-INTERM IF THE

1 APPLICANT IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-120-310.

2 **SECTION 29.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-120-313,
3 **recreate and reenact, with amendments,** (1) as follows:

4 **12-120-313. Qualifications for professional land surveyor.**

5 (1) (a) AN APPLICANT MAY QUALIFY FOR LICENSING AS A
6 PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR BY ENDORSEMENT AND EXAMINATION IF
7 THE APPLICANT PASSES THE APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION AS ADOPTED BY
8 THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 12-120-104 (3)(b) AND THE
9 EXAMINATION PERTAINING TO COLORADO LAW.

10 (b) TO BE ADMITTED TO AN EXAMINATION PURSUANT TO
11 SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION, AN APPLICANT MUST BE LICENSED IN
12 GOOD STANDING IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION REQUIRING QUALIFICATIONS
13 SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THOSE CURRENTLY REQUIRED OF
14 APPLICANTS UNDER THIS PART 3 OR, AT THE TIME OF INITIAL LICENSURE IN
15 THE OTHER JURISDICTION, MUST HAVE MET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
16 LICENSURE THEN IN EXISTENCE UNDER COLORADO LAW.

17 (c) UPON PASSING THE APPROPRIATE EXAMINATIONS, AN
18 APPLICANT QUALIFIED FOR LICENSING BY ENDORSEMENT AND
19 EXAMINATION PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE LICENSED AS
20 A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR IF THE APPLICANT IS OTHERWISE
21 QUALIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-120-312.

22 **SECTION 30.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-120-315,
23 **recreate and reenact, with amendments,** (1)(a)(III) and (1)(b)(III) as
24 follows:

25 **12-120-315. Fees - disposition.**

26 (1) Pursuant to section 12-20-105, the board shall charge and
27 collect fees for the following:

28 (a) With respect to professional land surveyors:

29 (III) APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT AND
30 EXAMINATION;

31 (b) With respect to land surveyor-interns:

32 (III) APPLICATION FOR ENROLLMENT AS A LAND
33 SURVEYOR-INTERM BY ENDORSEMENT."
