HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation, Housing & Local Government.

HB26-1318 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 2, strike "(2)" and substitute "(2); and  
2 **add** (4) and (5)".

3 Page 2, line 6, after "(2)" insert "(a)".

4 Page 2, line 9, strike "BOUNDARY. A" and substitute "BOUNDARY; EXCEPT  
5 THAT:

6 (I) STATE HIGHWAYS, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 42-4-110.5, ARE NOT  
7 INCLUDED IN A SCHOOL ZONE UNLESS DESIGNATED AS PART OF A SCHOOL  
8 ZONE BY THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OR BY A  
9 COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY WITH THE WRITTEN  
10 APPROVAL OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION;

11 (II) A SCHOOL ZONE THAT EXISTS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS  
12 SUBSECTION (2), AS AMENDED, THAT EXTENDS TO BETWEEN TWO  
13 HUNDRED FEET AND ONE THOUSAND FEET FROM A SCHOOL PROPERTY  
14 BOUNDARY IS THE SCHOOL ZONE FOR THAT SCHOOL PROPERTY; AND

15 (III) IF A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY THAT HAS  
16 JURISDICTION OVER A SCHOOL ZONE REDUCES THE SIZE OF THE SCHOOL  
17 ZONE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS SECTION, THEN ONLY THE  
18 REDUCED SCHOOL ZONE IS THE SCHOOL ZONE FOR THAT SCHOOL  
19 PROPERTY.

20 (b) A".

21 Page 2, line 17, strike "WHICH" and substitute "WHICH, EXCEPT IF  
22 REDUCED AS PERMITTED IN SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS SECTION,".

23 Page 2, after line 19 add:

24 "(4) A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY THAT HAS  
25 JURISDICTION OVER A SCHOOL ZONE MAY REDUCE THE SIZE OF THE SCHOOL  
26 ZONE TO EXTEND TO LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND FEET FROM A SCHOOL  
27 PROPERTY BOUNDARY BUT SHALL NOT REDUCE THE SIZE OF THE SCHOOL  
28 ZONE TO LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED FEET FROM A SCHOOL PROPERTY  
29 BOUNDARY. A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY SHALL NOT  
30 REDUCE THE SIZE OF A SCHOOL ZONE WITHOUT FIRST HOLDING A PUBLIC  
31 HEARING.

32 (5) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS A COUNTY, CITY AND  
33 COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY FROM INCREASING THE SIZE OF A SCHOOL ZONE  
34 TO LARGER THAN ONE THOUSAND FEET FROM A SCHOOL PROPERTY  
35 BOUNDARY OR, IN COLLABORATION WITH A LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD, FROM  
36 RAISING REVENUE THROUGH BONDING TO FINANCE INCREASED SCHOOL  
37 ZONE SIGNAGE.".

1 Page 3, after line 27 add:

2 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 42-4-119 as  
3 follows:

4 **42-4-119. Establishment of a school street - speed limit -**  
5 **definition.**

6 (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL STREET" MEANS A PORTION  
7 OF A ROADWAY IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO A SCHOOL PROPERTY  
8 BOUNDARY THAT IS DESIGNATED AS A SCHOOL STREET.

9 (2) A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY MAY  
10 DESIGNATE A ROADWAY AS A SCHOOL STREET; EXCEPT THAT A STATE  
11 HIGHWAY, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 42-4-110.5, MUST NOT BE DESIGNATED  
12 AS A SCHOOL STREET, UNLESS DESIGNATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION  
13 42-4-615 (2).

14 (3) A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY SHALL NOT  
15 DESIGNATE A ROADWAY THAT DIRECTLY CONNECTS TO A STATE HIGHWAY  
16 AS A SCHOOL STREET WITHOUT THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE  
17 COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

18 (4) A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY THAT  
19 DESIGNATES A ROADWAY AS A SCHOOL STREET MAY CLOSE THE SCHOOL  
20 STREET TO VEHICLES.

21 (5) ALL VEHICLES TRAVELING ALONG A SCHOOL STREET SHALL  
22 YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A PEDESTRIAN, BICYCLIST, OR  
23 MICROMOBILITY USER. A BICYCLIST OR OPERATOR OF A MICROMOBILITY  
24 DEVICE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A PEDESTRIAN ON A SCHOOL  
25 STREET.

26 (6) A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT HAVING JURISDICTION OVER  
27 THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON A  
28 SCHOOL STREET SHALL POST CONSPICUOUS TRAFFIC SIGNS INDICATING AN  
29 AREA DESIGNATED AS A SCHOOL STREET AS A SCHOOL STREET.

30 (7) THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON A SCHOOL STREET IS TEN MILES  
31 PER HOUR. A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT HAVING JURISDICTION OVER  
32 THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNS SHALL POST SPEED LIMIT SIGNS ON A  
33 SCHOOL STREET.

34 (8) SECTIONS 42-4-801, 42-4-803, AND 42-4-805 (1) AND (2) DO  
35 NOT APPLY TO SCHOOL STREETS.

36 (9) A COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR MUNICIPALITY THAT  
37 DESIGNATES A ROADWAY AS A SCHOOL STREET MAY SUSPEND ADDITIONAL  
38 TRAFFIC PROVISIONS ON THE SCHOOL STREET THAT ENDANGER  
39 PEDESTRIANS, BICYCLISTS, OR MICROMOBILITY USERS AND FRUSTRATE  
40 EASE OF PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE MOVEMENT."
