SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Transportation & Energy.

HB26-1007 be amended as follows:

1 Amend proposed committee amendment (HB1007\_L.012), page 1, line  
2 32, strike "OPERATION." and substitute "OPERATION.

3 (IV) A MUNICIPALLY OWNED UTILITY MAY DENY A PROPOSED  
4 CUSTOMER-OWNED METER COLLAR ADAPTER ONLY IF:

5 (A) THE PROPOSED METER COLLAR ADAPTER DOES NOT MEET THE  
6 REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (7)(c)(II) OF THIS SECTION; AND

7 (B) THE MUNICIPALLY OWNED UTILITY PROVIDES WRITTEN NOTICE  
8 TO THE PROPOSING PARTY THAT CLEARLY EXPLAINS WHY THE PROPOSED  
9 METER COLLAR ADAPTER FAILS TO MEET SAFETY REQUIREMENTS AND  
10 EXPLAINS THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE PROPOSED METER COLLAR  
11 ADAPTER AND A METER COLLAR ADAPTER THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY  
12 THE MUNICIPALLY OWNED UTILITY.

13 (V) IF THE INSTALLATION OF AN APPROVED METER COLLAR  
14 ADAPTER REQUIRES RELOCATION OF THE METER ENCLOSURE OR  
15 REPLACEMENT OF THE METER HOUSING, A MUNICIPALLY OWNED UTILITY  
16 SHALL, UPON REQUEST OF THE CUSTOMER, PROVIDE AN ESTIMATE OF THE  
17 COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NECESSARY LABOR AND EQUIPMENT OF THE  
18 MUNICIPALLY OWNED UTILITY, WHICH COSTS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF  
19 THE CUSTOMER. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION REQUIRES A MUNICIPALLY  
20 OWNED UTILITY TO MODIFY, RELOCATE, REPLACE, OR UPGRADE METERING  
21 INFRASTRUCTURE TO ACCOMMODATE THE INSTALLATION OF A METER  
22 COLLAR ADAPTER.

23 (VI) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (7)(c), "PROPOSING  
24 PARTY" MEANS A METER COLLAR ADAPTER MANUFACTURER."
