- 8 Page 266, line 13, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike

- 12 Page 283, line 9, strike "\$624,877" and substitute "\$924,877".

**PURPOSE:** Reduces the appropriations in the Office of the **Governor** by \$200,000 General Fund for the Office of Film, Television, and Media, and \$100,000 General Fund for Tourism Promotion and increases appropriations to the Offender Treatment and Services line item in the **Judicial** Department. Amends footnote number 56 to state the General Assembly's intent to dedicate the \$300,000 General Fund increase to offenders participating in Veterans' Treatment Courts.
