Representative Brown moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in adopting the following Winter T. amendment, (J.066, Amendment #6) to HB26-1410, to show that said amendment lost and that HB26-1410, as amended, was laid over to April 9, 2026.

Amend printed bill, page 36, line 4, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "14,571,090" and substitute "13,071,090" and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "14,571,090" and substitute "13,071,090".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

Page 413, line 3, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "11,829,465" and substitute "10,329,465" and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "8,936,546" and substitute "7,436,546".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

Page 468, line 8, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "7,730,013" and substitute "10,730,013" and in the GENERAL FUND column insert "3,000,000".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

PURPOSE: Makes \$1.5 million General Fund reductions each to the Superintendent Subprogram in the Department of **Corrections** and the Disease Control and Public Health Response Division in the Department of **Public Health and Environment**. Adds \$3.0 million General Fund to the Colorado Auto Theft Prevention Authority in the Department of **Public Safety**.
