

AMENDMENT TO REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Representative Marshall moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Marshall amendment, (J.051, Amendment #32) to HB26-1410, to show that said amendment passed and that HB26-1410, as amended, was laid over to April 9, 2026.

Amend printed bill, page 116, line 5, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "1,457,819" and substitute "1,257,819" and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "742,750" and substitute "542,750".

Page 116, line 11, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "17,676,740" and substitute "17,576,740" and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "3,743,930" and substitute "3,643,930".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

Page 266, line 13, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "22,461,853" and substitute "22,761,853" and in the GENERAL FUND column insert "300,000".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

Page 283, line 9, strike "\$624,877" and substitute "\$924,877".

PURPOSE: Reduces the appropriations in the Office of the **Governor** by \$200,000 General Fund for the Office of Film, Television, and Media, and \$100,000 General Fund for Tourism Promotion and increases appropriations to the Offender Treatment and Services line item in the **Judicial** Department. Amends footnote number 56 to state the General Assembly's intent to dedicate the \$300,000 General Fund increase to offenders participating in Veterans' Treatment Courts.
