Representative Marshall moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Marshall amendment, (J.065, Amendment #33) to HB26-1410, to show that said amendment passed and that HB26-1410, as amended, was laid over to April 9, 2026.

Amend printed bill, page 116, line 5, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "1,457,819" and substitute "1,186,029" and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "742,750" and substitute "470,960".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

Page 134, line 4, in the TOTAL column strike "15,196,700,682" and substitute "15,197,244,262", in the GENERAL FUND column strike "4,182,005,685(M)^{am}" and substitute "4,182,277,475(M)^{am}", and in the FEDERAL FUNDS column strike "9,000,590,475" and substitute "9,000,862,265".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

PURPOSE: Reduces funding to the **Governor's** Office by \$271,790 General Fund from the Colorado Office of Film, Television, and Media. Adds \$271,790 General Fund to the Department of **Health Care Policy and Financing** to delay implementation of the 56-hour per week soft cap on caregiver hours.
