7 **"SECTION 12. Appropriation - adjustments to 2026 long bill.**

8 (1) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$6,574,789 is appropriated to the  
9 department of health care policy and financing. To implement this act, the  
10 department may use this appropriation as follows:

11 (a) \$396,038 from the adult dental fund created in section  
12 25.5-5-207 (4)(a), C.R.S., for medical and long-term care services for  
13 Medicaid-eligible individuals; and

14 (b) \$6,178,751 from the general fund for health benefits for  
15 children lacking access due to immigration status.

16 (2) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, the general assembly  
17 anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will  
18 receive \$735,499 in federal funds to implement this act. The  
19 appropriation in subsection (1) of this section is based on the assumption  
20 that the department will receive this amount of federal funds to be used  
21 for medical and long-term care services for Medicaid-eligible individuals.

22 **SECTION 13. Appropriation - adjustments to 2026 long bill.**

23 (1) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$6,574,789 is appropriated to the  
24 department of health care policy and financing. To implement this act, the  
25 department may use this appropriation as follows:

26 (a) \$396,038 from the general fund for medical and long-term care  
27 services for Medicaid-eligible individuals; and

28 (b) \$6,178,751 from the general fund for health benefits for  
29 children lacking access due to immigration status.

30 (2) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, the general assembly  
31 anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will  
32 receive \$735,499 in federal funds to implement this act. The  
33 appropriation in subsection (1) of this section is based on the assumption  
34 that the department will receive this amount of federal funds to be used  
35 for medical and long-term care services for Medicaid-eligible individuals.

3 takes effect on the effective date of this act or the effective date of House  
4 Bill 26-1410, whichever is later.  
5           (2) Section 12 of this act takes effect only if House Bill 26-1401  
6 does not become law, in which case section 12 takes effect on the  
7 effective date of this act.  
8           (3) Section 13 of this act takes effect only if House Bill 26-1401  
9 and House Bill 26-1410 become law, in which case section 13 takes  
10 effect on the effective date of this act, the effective date of House Bill  
11 26-1401, or the effective date of House Bill 26-1410, whichever is later."  
12 Renumber the succeeding section accordingly.
