

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend printed bill, page 7, line 2, strike "24-6-303.5," and substitute
2 "24-6-303.5 OR 24-6-303.7,".

3 Page 8, line 27, strike "AND THE JUDICIAL BRANCH".

4 Page 9, lines 3 and 4, strike "department OR THE JUDICIAL BRANCH." and
5 substitute "department.".

6 Page 9, line 5, strike "JUDICIAL BRANCH,".

7 Page 10, lines 4 and 5, strike "AN INDIVIDUAL LOBBYING ON BEHALF OF
8 THE JUDICIAL BRANCH,".

9 Page 11, strike lines 6 through 8.

10 Page 11, line 10, strike "THE JUDICIAL BRANCH,".

11 Page 11, after line 14 insert:

12 **"SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 24-6-303.7 as
13 follows:

14 **24-6-303.7. Lobbying by judicial department officials and**
15 **employees - independent agencies - definition.**

16 (1) (a) THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT AND EACH OF ITS INDEPENDENT
17 AGENCIES MAY DESIGNATE AT LEAST ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
18 RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOBBYING OF THE TYPE DEFINED IN SECTION
19 24-6-301 (3.5)(a)(I) OR (3.5)(a)(III) ON BEHALF OF THE JUDICIAL
20 DEPARTMENT OR ANY OF ITS INDEPENDENT AGENCIES.

21 (b) (I) A DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL SHALL REGISTER WITH THE
22 SECRETARY OF STATE BY FILING A WRITTEN STATEMENT ON OR BEFORE
23 JANUARY 15 OF EACH YEAR. THE WRITTEN REGISTRATION STATEMENT
24 MUST BE ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND MUST
25 INCLUDE THE DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL'S FULL LEGAL NAME, JUDICIAL
26 DEPARTMENT OR INDEPENDENT AGENCY'S ADDRESS, AND BUSINESS
27 TELEPHONE NUMBER.

28 (II) IF ANY INFORMATION ON THE ORIGINAL WRITTEN STATEMENT
29 CHANGES, THE DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL SHALL FILE AN AMENDMENT TO
30 THE STATEMENT WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE WITHIN SEVEN CALENDAR
31 DAYS OF THE CHANGE.

32 (c) A DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL SHALL FILE COPIES OF THE
33 ORIGINAL WRITTEN REGISTRATION STATEMENT, ANY ACCOMPANYING

1 DOCUMENTS, AND ANY AMENDMENTS TO THE REGISTRATION STATEMENT
2 WITH THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE, THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE, AND THE
3 CHIEF CLERK OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WITHIN SEVEN
4 CALENDAR DAYS OF FILING THE DOCUMENT WITH THE SECRETARY OF
5 STATE.

6 (d) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "INDEPENDENT AGENCY"
7 MEANS AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY OF THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT,
8 INCLUDING AN AGENCY IDENTIFIED AS ONE OF THE "INCLUDED AGENCIES"
9 IDENTIFIED IN SECTION 13-100-102 (3) AND THE OFFICE OF THE STATE
10 PUBLIC DEFENDER CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21-1-101.

11 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE WRITTEN REGISTRATION STATEMENT FILED
12 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, A DESIGNATED
13 INDIVIDUAL SHALL DISCLOSE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE THE
14 LEGISLATION ON WHICH LOBBYING OF THE TYPE DEFINED IN SECTION
15 24-6-301 (3.5)(a)(I) OR (3.5)(a)(III) IS BEING PERFORMED BY THE
16 DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL AND THE POSITION THAT THE DESIGNATED
17 INDIVIDUAL IS TAKING ON BEHALF OF THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT OR
18 INDEPENDENT AGENCY AS EITHER SUPPORTING, OPPOSING, AMENDING, OR
19 MONITORING THE LEGISLATION. IF THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT OR AN
20 INDEPENDENT AGENCY'S POSITION CHANGES, THE DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL
21 SHALL UPDATE THE POSITION DISCLOSURE WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE
22 WITHIN SEVENTY-TWO HOURS OF THE CHANGE.

23 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ENGAGES IN LOBBYING FOR THE JUDICIAL
24 DEPARTMENT OR AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY BUT WHO IS NOT A JUDICIAL
25 DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEE OR INDEPENDENT AGENCY EMPLOYEE SHALL
26 COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 24-6-302 AND 24-6-303.

27 (4) A DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL LOBBYING ON BEHALF OF THE
28 JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT OR AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY IS EXEMPT FROM THE
29 REGISTRATION AND DISCLOSURE FEES IMPOSED BY SECTIONS 24-6-302 AND
30 24-6-303.

31 (5) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO MUNICIPAL, STATE, OR
32 FEDERAL JUDGES OR MAGISTRATES."
