1 Amend printed bill, page 14, after line 12 insert:

2 **"12-247-113. Scope of practice - licensed behavioral analysts.**

3 (1) (a) THE PRACTICE OF BEHAVIORAL ANALYSIS INCLUDES THE
4 DESIGN, IMPLEMENTATION, AND EVALUATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL
5 MODIFICATIONS USING BEHAVIORAL STIMULI AND CONSEQUENCES TO
6 PRODUCE SOCIALLY SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT IN HUMAN BEHAVIOR,
7 INCLUDING THE USE OF DIRECT OBSERVATION, MEASUREMENT, AND
8 FUNCTIONAL ANALYSIS OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN ENVIRONMENT
9 AND BEHAVIOR, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING TREATMENT.

10 (b) THE PRACTICE OF BEHAVIORAL ANALYSIS MAY INCLUDE OTHER
11 PRACTICES AS DEFINED BY THE BOARD.

12 (2) A LICENSED BEHAVIORAL ANALYST SHALL SUPERVISE AN
13 APPROPRIATE NUMBER OF ASSISTANT BEHAVIORAL ANALYSTS OR
14 BEHAVIORAL TECHNICIANS AT A TIME AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.

15 (3) (a) A LICENSED BEHAVIOR ANALYST SHALL DEVELOP AN
16 INDIVIDUALIZED TREATMENT PLAN FOR APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS
17 THAT WILL GUIDE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TREATMENT GOALS,
18 TREATMENT INTENSITY, AND SERVICE DELIVERY.

19 (b) AN INDIVIDUALIZED TREATMENT PLAN DESCRIBED IN
20 SUBSECTION (3)(a) OF THIS SECTION MUST IDENTIFY AND DEVELOP
21 OBJECTIVE AND MEASURABLE TREATMENT GOALS TO ADDRESS PROBLEM
22 AREAS THAT WERE IDENTIFIED THROUGH THE USE OF STANDARDIZED
23 CRITERIA REFERENCED BY THE PLAN OR OTHER ASSESSMENTS FOR INITIAL
24 AND ONGOING ASSESSMENT AND PROGRESS MONITORING. THE TREATMENT
25 GOALS SHALL BE DEFINED APPROPRIATE TO PROPOSED TREATMENT
26 INTENSITY AND SERVICE DELIVERY."
