

HB26-1418 be amended as follows:

1 Amend the Finance Committee Report, dated April 27, 2026, page 11,  
2 after line 40 insert:

3 **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2026-27 state fiscal  
4 year, \$294,984 is appropriated to the department of revenue. This  
5 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
6 department may use this appropriation as follows:

7 (a) \$8,778 for use by the executive director's office for personal  
8 services related to administration and support;

9 (b) \$247,627 for tax administration IT system (GenTax) support;

10 (c) \$12,079 for use by taxation business group for personal  
11 services related to taxation services, which amount is based on an  
12 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.2 FTE; and

13 (d) \$26,500 for the purchase of legal services.

14 (2) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$26,500 is appropriated to  
15 the department of law. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds  
16 received from the department of revenue under subsection (1)(d) of this  
17 section and is based on an assumption that the department of law will  
18 require an addition 0.1 FTE. To implement this act, the department of law  
19 may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the department of  
20 revenue.

21 (3) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$145,750 is appropriated to  
22 the department of law. This appropriation is from the youth mental health  
23 services access enterprise fund created in section 27-60-604 (6)(a),  
24 C.R.S., from revenue received from the youth mental health services  
25 access enterprise that is continuously appropriated to the enterprise  
26 pursuant to section 27-60-604 (6)(c), C.R.S. The appropriation to the  
27 department of law is based on an assumption that the department of law  
28 will require an additional 0.6 FTE. To implement this act, the department  
29 of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the youth  
30 mental health services access enterprise.

31 (4) For the 2026-27 state fiscal year, \$79,500 is appropriated to  
32 the department of law. This appropriation is from the youth programming  
33 and protections enterprise fund created in section 22-109-104 (6)(a),  
34 C.R.S., from revenue received from the youth programming and  
35 protections enterprise that is continuously appropriated to the enterprise  
36 pursuant to section 22-109-104 (6)(c), C.R.S. The appropriation to the  
37 department of law is based on an assumption that the department of law  
38 will require an additional 0.3 FTE. To implement this act, the department  
39 of law may use this appropriation to provide legal services for the youth  
40 programming and protections enterprise."
