1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 18, line 27, strike ""Shall state" and
 2 substitute ""Shall the state take the entirety of the taxpayers' the
 3 Taxpayer's Bill of Rights refunds for increasing investment in K-12
 4 public education by two percent each year for the next ten years, with
 5 investments used to increase teacher pay, improve teacher retention,
 6 lower class sizes, and increase access to career and technical courses,
 7 funded by raising the annual limit on state fiscal year spending only by
 8 the amount spent on public K-12 education as a voter-approved revenue
 9 change, and requiring an annual publicly related, independent audit to
 10 show how the new investments are spent?" Except as otherwise provided
 11 in section 1-40-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, if a majority of the
 12 electors voting on the ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the act will become
 13 part of the Colorado Revised Statutes."
