

AMENDMENT TO REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Representative Johnson moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Richardson amendment, (L.013) to SB26-042, to show that said amendment passed and that SB26-042, as amended, passed.

Amend reengrossed bill, page 9, strike lines 8 through 12 and substitute:

"SECTION 7. Refer to people under referendum. At the election held on November 3, 2026, the secretary of state shall submit this act by its ballot title to the registered electors of the state for their approval or rejection. Each elector voting at the election may cast a vote either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall there be a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes modifying existing law and creating new law concerning the classification of certain state revenue for the purposes of calculating state fiscal year spending pursuant to section 20 of article X of the state constitution, and, in connection therewith, clarifying the statutory definitions of collections for another government and damage awards?" Except as otherwise provided in section 1-40-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, if a majority of the electors voting on the ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the act will become part of the Colorado Revised Statutes."
