Representative Luck moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Luck amendment, (L.034) to SB26-135, to show that said amendment passed and that SB26-135, as amended, passed.

Amend reengrossed bill, page 18, strike line 27 and substitute "either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall there be a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes allowing the state to keep and spend an amount of state revenue equal to one year of state public K-12 education funding as a voter-approved revenue change under the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights, and, in connection therewith, requiring the state to use a portion of the money to increase state funding for public K-12 education for ten years; and allowing the state to use the rest of the money for any purpose determined by the state legislature?" Except as otherwise provided in section 1-40-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, if a majority of the electors voting on the ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the act will become part of the Colorado Revised Statutes."
