16 RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION  
17 24-48.5-129 (4)(a).

25 SURCHARGE FUND TO THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC  
26 DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-48.5-129 (4)(a).

32       **legislative declaration.** (4) (a) THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC  
33 DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND IS CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE  
34 FUND CONSISTS OF MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND PURSUANT TO  
35 SECTION 44-40-111 (12)(b) AND ANY OTHER MONEY THAT THE GENERAL  
36 ASSEMBLY MAY APPROPRIATE OR TRANSFER TO THE FUND.37       (b) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST AND  
38 INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF MONEY IN THE  
39 OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND TO THE FUND

1 UNTIL MONEY IS FIRST TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION  
2 44-40-111 (12)(b). THEREAFTER, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT  
3 ALL INTEREST AND INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT  
4 OF MONEY IN THE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.

5 (c) MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE OUTDOOR RECREATION  
6 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 44-40-111  
7 (12)(b) AND ANY INCOME AND INTEREST DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND  
8 INVESTMENT OF SUCH MONEY IS EXEMPT FROM ANY RESTRICTION ON  
9 SPENDING, REVENUE, OR APPROPRIATIONS, INCLUDING, WITHOUT  
10 LIMITATION, THE RESTRICTIONS OF SECTION 20 OF ARTICLE X OF THE  
11 STATE CONSTITUTION.

12 (d) SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BY THE GENERAL  
13 ASSEMBLY, THE OUTDOOR RECREATION INDUSTRY OFFICE MAY EXPEND  
14 MONEY FROM THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH  
15 FUND TO EXECUTE ITS DUTIES AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS  
16 SECTION. ANY MONEY APPROPRIATED FROM THE FUND THAT IS NOT  
17 EXPENDED OR ENCUMBERED AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR REMAINS  
18 AVAILABLE FOR EXPENDITURE BY THE OUTDOOR RECREATION INDUSTRY  
19 OFFICE FOR THE NEXT TWO FISCAL YEARS WITHOUT FURTHER  
20 APPROPRIATION.

21 (5) THE OUTDOOR RECREATION INDUSTRY OFFICE MAY SEEK,  
22 ACCEPT, AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS, LOANS OF MONEY,

26 DONATIONS TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE MONEY TO  
27 THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND.

34 FROM THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CENTER CASH FUND TO THE  
35 OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND CREATED IN  
36 SECTION 24-48.5-129 (4)(a).

9 RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION  
10 24-48.5-129 (4)(a).

16 accepted by the adjutant general pursuant to section 28-3-106 (1)(x) shall  
17 be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit the same to the  
18 department of military and veterans affairs fund, which fund is **hereby**  
19 created and referred to in this section as the "fund". **The moneys** MONEY  
20 in the fund shall be invested by the state treasurer as provided in sections  
21 24-36-109, 24-36-112, and 24-36-113. ~~C.R.S.~~ Any unexpended and  
22 unencumbered **moneys** MONEY remaining in the fund at the end of any  
23 fiscal year shall remain in the fund and shall not revert or be credited or  
24 transferred to the general fund or be transferred to any other fund. Any  
25 interest or income derived from the deposit and investment of moneys in  
26 the fund ~~shall remain~~ REMAINS in the fund. ~~and shall not be credited to the~~

2 THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND

35 **40-10.1-509. Outreach - fund - transfer - repeal.** (1) The  
36 moving outreach fund is ~~hereby~~ created in the state treasury. The fund  
37 consists of one-half the penalties collected from movers and credited to  
38 the fund under section 40-7-112. The commission shall use the fund to  
39 educate consumers about their rights and the responsibilities of movers  
40 under this part 5. This outreach includes public service announcements  
41 about the licensing of movers. ~~The moneys~~ MONEY in the fund and any

8 **SECTION 15.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 42-1-226 as  
9 follows:

10 **42-1-226. Disabled parking education and enforcement fund**  
11 **- created - transfer - repeal.** (1) There is hereby created in the state  
12 treasury the disabled parking education and enforcement fund, which  
13 consists of money collected pursuant to this section and section  
14 42-4-1208 (6) and (7). The general assembly shall appropriate the money  
15 in the fund for the purposes specified in sections 42-1-227, 42-3-204, and  
16 42-4-1208. Unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund at the end  
17 of a fiscal year remains in the fund and shall not be credited or transferred  
18 to the general fund or another fund. The department may accept gifts,  
19 grants, or donations from private or public sources for the purposes of this  
20 section. All private and public money received through gifts, grants, or  
21 donations must be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit the  
22 money to the fund.

23 (2)(a) ON JUNE 30, 2025, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER  
24 ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE  
25 DOLLARS FROM THE DISABLED PARKING EDUCATION AND ENFORCEMENT  
26 FUND TO THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND  
27 CREATED IN SECTION 24-48.5-129 (4)(a).

28 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (2) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026.".

8 **"SECTION 17. Appropriation.** For the 2025-26 state fiscal year,  
9 \$723,488 is appropriated to the office of economic development for use  
10 by the outdoor recreation industry office. This appropriation is from the  
11 outdoor recreation economic development cash fund created in section  
12 24-48.5-129 (4), C.R.S. To implement this act, the outdoor recreation  
13 industry office may use this appropriation to execute its duties as set forth  
14 in section 24-48.5-129 (3), C.R.S. In accordance with section 24-48.5-129  
15 (4)(d), C.R.S., any money appropriated in this section not expended prior  
16 to July 1, 2026, is further appropriated to the outdoor recreation industry  
17 office for the 2026-27 and 2027-28 state fiscal years for the same  
18 purpose.

19 **SECTION 18. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,  
20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
21 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for  
22 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state  
23 institutions.".

24 Page 1, line 105, strike the third "AND".

25 Page 1, line 107, strike "THE OUTDOOR RECREATION INDUSTRY OFFICE,"  
26 and substitute "A NEW OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC  
27 DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND,".

28 Page 1, line 109, strike "FUND." and substitute "FUND, MAKING  
29 ADDITIONAL TRANSFERS TO THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMIC  
30 DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.".
