33 DEVELOPMENT CASH FUND IS CREATED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE
34 FUND CONSISTS OF MONEY TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND PURSUANT TO
35 SECTION 44-40-111 (12)(b) AND ANY OTHER MONEY THAT THE GENERAL
36 ASSEMBLY MAY APPROPRIATE OR TRANSFER TO THE FUND.

37 (b) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL INTEREST AND
38 INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF MONEY IN THE

16 42-4-1208. Unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund at the end
17 of a fiscal year remains in the fund and shall not be credited or transferred
18 to the general fund or another fund. The department may accept gifts,
19 grants, or donations from private or public sources for the purposes of this
20 section. All private and public money received through gifts, grants, or
21 donations must be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit the
22 money to the fund.

8 **"SECTION 17. Appropriation.** For the 2025-26 state fiscal year,
9 \$723,488 is appropriated to the office of economic development for use
10 by the outdoor recreation industry office. This appropriation is from the
11 outdoor recreation economic development cash fund created in section
12 24-48.5-129 (4), C.R.S. To implement this act, the outdoor recreation
13 industry office may use this appropriation to execute its duties as set forth
14 in section 24-48.5-129 (3), C.R.S. In accordance with section 24-48.5-129
15 (4)(d), C.R.S., any money appropriated in this section not expended prior
16 to July 1, 2026, is further appropriated to the outdoor recreation industry
