

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend the Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report, dated April 3,
2 2025, page 7, strike lines 28 to 38 and substitute:

3 "(7.5)(a)(I) ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2026, A TRANSPORTATION
4 NETWORK COMPANY SHALL:

5 (A) ENSURE THAT CONTINUOUS AUDIO RECORDING OF THE DRIVER
6 IS CONDUCTED FOR EACH PREARRANGED RIDE FROM WHEN THE DRIVER
7 PICKS UP THE RIDER IN A PERSONAL VEHICLE UNTIL WHEN THE RIDER
8 DEPARTS FROM THE PERSONAL VEHICLE;

9 (B) NOTIFY THE DRIVER IN AN ONLINE APPLICATION THAT EACH
10 PREARRANGED RIDE IS CONTINUOUSLY AUDIO RECORDED; AND

11 (C) ENSURE THAT EACH RIDER IN A PREARRANGED RIDE IS
12 NOTIFIED IN THE PERSONAL VEHICLE THAT THE RIDE IS CONTINUOUSLY
13 AUDIO RECORDED.

14 (II) ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 2026, A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK
15 COMPANY SHALL:

16 (A) ENSURE THAT CONTINUOUS AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDING OF
17 THE DRIVER IS CONDUCTED FOR EACH PREARRANGED RIDE FROM WHEN
18 THE DRIVER PICKS UP THE RIDER IN A PERSONAL VEHICLE UNTIL WHEN THE
19 RIDER DEPARTS FROM THE PERSONAL VEHICLE;

20 (B) NOTIFY THE DRIVER IN AN ONLINE APPLICATION THAT EACH
21 PREARRANGED RIDE IS CONTINUOUSLY AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDED; AND

22 (C) ENSURE THAT EACH RIDER IN A PREARRANGED RIDE IS
23 NOTIFIED IN THE PERSONAL VEHICLE THAT THE RIDE IS CONTINUOUSLY
24 AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDED.

25 (b) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2025, THE COMMISSION SHALL
26 ADOPT RULES:

27 (I) ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR RETENTION OF, ACCESS TO,
28 STORAGE OF, AND ENCRYPTION OF AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDING
29 CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (7.5)(a) OF THIS SECTION;

30 (II) REQUIRING A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY TO
31 REIMBURSE A DRIVER FOR PURCHASING TECHNOLOGY TO ENABLE AUDIO
32 AND VIDEO RECORDING CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (7.5)(a)
33 OF THIS SECTION; AND

34 (III) GOVERNING TECHNOLOGY FAILURES RELATED TO AUDIO AND
35 VIDEO RECORDING CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (7.5)(a) OF THIS
36 SECTION."

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
