SB24-135 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 5, strike lines 16 through 27.
- 2 Strike page 6.
- 3 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 15.
- 4 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 5 Page 7, line 16, strike "**repeal**" and substitute "**amend**".
- 6 Page 7, line 18, strike "**On**".
- 7 Page 7, strike lines 19 through 27.
- 8 Page 8, strike lines 1 through 8 and substitute "On or before December 1
9 of each year, ~~it shall be the duty~~ of the district attorney and the county
10 attorney ~~to~~ SHALL make a written report to the ~~governor of the state~~
11 JUDICIARY COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE

19 any court costs or other expenses necessary for the prosecution of any suit
20 provided for in this ~~article~~ ARTICLE 7. Nothing in this ~~article~~ ARTICLE 7
21 shall be construed to repeal any law of this state concerning the
22 responsibility of parents to support their children, ~~or~~ providing for the
23 punishment of parents or other persons responsible for the delinquency
24 or dependency of children, or providing for the punishment of any parents
25 for the nonsupport of their children; and nothing in such law shall prevent
26 proceedings under this ~~article~~ ARTICLE 7 in any proper case.".
