2 16, 2025, page 1, after line 6 insert:

3 "Page 4 of the reengrossed bill, strike lines 10 through 21 and substitute:

4 **"SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
5 **applicability.** (1) Section 6-1-732 (1)(d), Colorado Revised Statutes, as
6 enacted in section 1 of this act, takes effect February 16, 2026, and the
7 remainder of the act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the
8 expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general
9 assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section
10 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item,
11 section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section,
12 or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general
13 election to be held in November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect
14 on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

15 (2) This act applies to automatic renewal contracts offered or
16 renewed on or after the applicable effective date of this act.". ".
