SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

BY SENATOR Cutter

1 Amend the Business, Labor, and Technology Committee Report, dated
2 March 12, 2024, page 1, strike line 10 and substitute:

3 "Page 4 of the printed bill, line 5, strike "(20)(c)(I);" and substitute "(9)(a)
4 and (20)(c);" and strike "(2.5)," and substitute "(4)(c),".

5 Page 4 of the bill, after line 22 insert:

6 "(4) (c) "COOKWARE" DOES NOT INCLUDE FOOD EQUIPMENT
7 INTENDED PRIMARILY FOR USE IN COMMERCIAL SETTINGS, INCLUDING
8 FOOD EQUIPMENT SOLD TO A BUSINESS THAT HAS A RETAIL FOOD
9 ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE."

10 Page 4 of the bill, after line 26 insert:

11 "(9) (a) "Fabric treatment" means a product applied to fabric to
12 ~~give the fabric one or more characteristics, including stain resistance and~~
13 ~~water resistance~~ FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING FOR CONSUMER USE,
14 PREMARKET USE, AND AFTERMARKET USE."

15 Page 5 of the bill, strike lines 17 through 20 and substitute:

16 "(20) (c) "Product" does not include:

17 (I) Drugs, medical devices, biologics, or diagnostics ~~approved or~~
18 ~~authorized~~ USED IN A MEDICAL SETTING OR IN MEDICAL APPLICATIONS
19 REGULATED by the federal food and drug administration; ~~or the federal~~
20 ~~department of agriculture; or~~

21 (II) Veterinary pesticide AND PARASITICIDE products approved by
22 the federal environmental protection agency OR THE FEDERAL
23 DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE for use in animals; ~~or~~

24 (II.5) BIOLOGICS OR DIAGNOSTICS APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL
25 DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR USE IN A VETERINARY SETTING OR IN
26 VETERINARY APPLICATIONS; OR

27 (III) Packaging used for the products described in subsections
28 (20)(c)(I), ~~and~~ (20)(c)(II), OR (20)(c)(II.5) of this section."

29 Page 1 of the report, strike lines 12 through 16 and substitute:

30 "Page 6 of the bill, line 7, strike "**amend**".

31 Page 6 of the bill, strike line 8 and substitute "**add** (2)(g), (2.5), (3.5), and
32 (5) as follows:"

33 Page 6 of the bill, line 12, strike "2025." and substitute "2026."

- 1 Page 6 of the bill, strike lines 22 through 27.
- 2 Page 7 of the bill, strike lines 1 through 6 and substitute:
- 3 "(3.5) ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2026, A PERSON SHALL NOT
- 4 SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, DISTRIBUTE FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTE FOR USE IN
- 5 THE STATE THE FOLLOWING PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN INTENTIONALLY
- 6 ADDED PFAS CHEMICALS:
- 7 (a) COOKWARE;
- 8 (b) DENTAL FLOSS;
- 9 (c) MENSTRUATION PRODUCTS; AND
- 10 (d) SKI WAX."
- 11 Page 7 of the bill, line 8, strike "AN".
- 12 Page 7 of the bill, strike lines 9 and 10 and substitute "THE FOLLOWING
- 13 PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN INTENTIONALLY ADDED PFAS CHEMICALS:
- 14 (a) TEXTILE ARTICLES;
- 15 (b) OUTDOOR APPAREL FOR SEVERE WET CONDITIONS; AND
- 16 (c) FOOD EQUIPMENT INTENDED PRIMARILY FOR USE IN
- 17 COMMERCIAL SETTINGS THAT COMES INTO DIRECT CONTACT WITH
- 18 FOOD."."
- 19 Strike "JULY 1, 2024" and substitute "JANUARY 1, 2026" on: **Page 8** of the
- 20 bill, lines 10 and 11 and 15.

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
