

HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on Judiciary.

HB24-1460 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 4, strike lines 6 through 27.
- 2 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 3 Page 5, line 17, after "(2)(a)" insert "and (2)(b)(III)".
- 4 Page 5, line 19, after "is" insert "AN OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING OR".
- 5 Page 5, line 21, after "in" insert "THE OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING OR".
- 6 Page 5, line 27, strike "THE" and substitute "NOTWITHSTANDING THE
- 7 PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 24-72-205 AND 24-72-306, THE".
- 8 Page 6, after line 3 insert:
 - 9 "(b) (III) Any video that would substantially interfere with or
 - 10 jeopardize an active or ongoing investigation may be withheld from the
 - 11 public; except that the video shall be released no later than forty-five days
 - 12 from the date of the OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING OR THE allegation of
 - 13 misconduct; except that in a case in which the only offenses charged are
 - 14 statutory traffic infractions, the release of the video may be delayed
 - 15 pursuant to rule 8 of the Colorado rules for traffic infractions. In all cases
 - 16 when release of a video is delayed in reliance on this subsection
 - 17 (2)(b)(III), the prosecuting attorney shall prepare a written explanation of
 - 18 the interference or jeopardy that justifies the delayed release,
 - 19 contemporaneous with the refusal to release the video. Upon release of
 - 20 the video, the prosecuting attorney shall release the written explanation
 - 21 to the public."

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
