5 YEARS OF AGE.

7            (A) PRODUCTS WITH NO THC;  
8            (B) TINCTURES;  
9            (C) COSMETICS; OR

10            (D) A HEMP PRODUCT THAT THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG  
11 ADMINISTRATION HAS DETERMINED IS GENERALLY RECOGNIZED AS SAFE  
12 UNDER THE "FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT", 21 U.S.C. SEC.  
13 301 ET SEQ.

14        (f) (I) SELLING A HEMP PRODUCT WITH ONE-HALF MILLIGRAM OR  
15 LESS OF THC PER SERVING TO A PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF  
16 AGE IN A PACKAGE OF MORE THAN TEN SERVINGS; OR

17            (II) SELLING MORE THAN THREE PACKAGES WITH NO MORE THAN  
18 TEN SERVINGS EACH OF HEMP PRODUCTS WITH ONE-HALF MILLIGRAM OR  
19 LESS OF THC PER SERVING IN A PACKAGE TO A PERSON UNDER  
20 TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE.

21            (III) THIS SUBSECTION (8)(f) DOES NOT APPLY TO:

22            (A) PRODUCTS WITH NO THC;  
23            (B) TINCTURES;  
24            (C) COSMETICS; OR

25            (D) A HEMP PRODUCT THAT THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG  
26 ADMINISTRATION HAS DETERMINED IS GENERALLY RECOGNIZED AS SAFE
