

## SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, before line 1 insert:

2 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 42-1-230 as  
3 follows:

4 **42-1-230. Exceptions processing - rules.** Beginning September  
5 1, 2014, the department of revenue shall provide the opportunity for  
6 exceptions processing in person at a minimum of four regional offices  
7 that are actually operated by the department of revenue and that issue  
8 driver's licenses. The department shall promulgate rules to implement  
9 exceptions processing for documents issued under parts 1, 2, 3, and 5 of  
10 article 2 of this title. ~~The department shall not use exceptions processing~~  
11 ~~for noncitizens to establish lawful status in the United States~~ TITLE 42."

12 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

13 Page 3, line 2, strike "and **repeal** (1)(c)" and substitute "**repeal** (1)(c); and  
14 **add** (4)".

15 Page 4, line 6, strike "passport OR PHOTOCOPY OF A PASSPORT;" and  
16 substitute "passport;".

17 Page 4, strike lines 12 through 27 and substitute:

18 "(II) ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2027, AN IDENTIFYING DOCUMENT  
19 OR A COMBINATION OF IDENTIFYING DOCUMENTS ISSUED BY AN AGENCY  
20 OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT OR ITS CONTRACTORS OR  
21 SUBCONTRACTORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES PROMULGATED BY THE  
22 DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (4) OF THIS SECTION.

23 (4) **Rules.** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE RULES  
24 ESTABLISHING EXCEPTIONS PROCESSING TO ISSUE AN IDENTIFICATION  
25 DOCUMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION AND DETERMINING THE  
26 TYPES OF DOCUMENTS, THE STANDARDS FOR THE DOCUMENTS, AND THE  
27 COMBINATION OF THE DOCUMENTS ISSUED BY AN AGENCY OF THE UNITED  
28 STATES GOVERNMENT OR ITS CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS. THE  
29 RULES MUST ADDRESS THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

30 (a) AN IDENTIFYING DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES  
31 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, ITS CONTRACTORS OR  
32 SUBCONTRACTORS, OR THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE,  
33 INCLUDING FORM I-862, NOTICE TO APPEAR; FORM I-200, WARRANT FOR  
34 ARREST OF ALIEN; FORM I-205, WARRANT OF DEPORTATION; FORM

1 I-220A, ORDER OF RELEASE ON RECOGNIZANCE; AND FORM 220B, ORDER  
2 OF SUPERVISION, OR THE SUCCESSOR TO ANY OF THE LISTED FORMS;  
3 (b) AN IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT ISSUED UNDER THE INTENSIVE  
4 SUPERVISION APPEARANCE PROGRAM BY THE UNITED STATES  
5 IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT AGENCY WITHIN THE UNITED  
6 STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY; OR  
7 (c) A VERIFICATION-OF-RELEASE DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE OFFICE  
8 OF REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT IN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF  
9 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.  
10 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date -**  
11 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect March 31, 2025; except that, if a  
12 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
13 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
14 within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general  
15 assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless  
16 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November  
17 2024 and, in such case, will take effect March 31, 2025, or on the date of  
18 the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor, whichever is  
19 later.".

20 Page 5, strike lines 1 through 8.

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
