CONCERNING THE EXEMPTION OF THE COLORADO FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS FUND FROM THE MAXIMUM RESERVE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1228, add (3)(d) as follows:

24-33.5-1228. Colorado firefighting air corps - creation - powers - aircraft acquisitions required - center of excellence - unmanned aircraft systems study and pilot program - Colorado firefighting air corps fund - creation - report - rules. (3) (d) THE COLORADO FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS FUND IS EXEMPT FROM THE LIMITATIONS SET FORTH IN SECTION 24-75-402.

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-402, amend (5)(aa) as follows:

24-75-402. Cash funds - limit on uncommitted reserves - reduction in amount of fees - exclusions - repeal. (5) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, the following cash funds are excluded from the limitations specified in this section:

(aa) The emergency fire fund created in section 24-33.5-1220 (2), the wildland fire equipment repair cash fund created in section 24-33.5-1220 (3), the wildland fire cost recovery fund created in section 24-33.5-1220 (4), the wildfire emergency response fund created in section 24-33.5-1226 (1), ~~and~~ the wildfire preparedness fund created in section 24-33.5-1227 (1), AND THE COLORADO FIREFIGHTING AIR CORPS FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1228 (3);

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.


