Fiscal note status: This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Joint Budget Committee as part of the FY 2025-26 supplemental budget package.

Summary Information

Overview. The bill transfers \$3.6 million from the General Fund to the IT Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund in FY 2025-26.

Types of impacts. The bill is projected to affect the following areas in FY 2025-26 only:

Summary of Legislation

The bill transfers \$3.6 million from the General Fund to the Information Technology (IT) Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund on April 1, 2026.

State Transfers

In the current FY 2025-26, the bill transfers \$3,646,420 from the General Fund to the IT Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
