**Fiscal note status:** This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Joint Budget Committee as part of the FY 2025-26 supplemental budget package.

**Overview.** The bill transfers \$3.6 million from the General Fund to the IT Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund in FY 2025-26.

**Types of impacts.** The bill is projected to affect the following areas in FY 2025-26 only:

## Summary of Legislation

---

The bill transfers \$3.6 million from the General Fund to the Information Technology (IT) Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund on April 1, 2026.

In the current FY 2025-26, the bill transfers \$3,646,420 from the General Fund to the IT Capital Account of the Capital Construction Fund.

## Effective Date

---

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
