101      **CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COMPLIANCE ADVISORY**  
102              **PANEL TO THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DIVISION IN THE**  
103              **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT, AND, IN**  
104              **CONNECTION THEREWITH, IMPLEMENTING THE**  
105              **RECOMMENDATION CONTAINED IN THE 2025 SUNSET REPORT BY**  
106              **THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.**

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**Bill Summary**

**Sunset Process - House Energy and Environment Committee.**

Pursuant to the recommendation in the 2025 sunset report by the department of regulatory agencies, the bill continues the compliance advisory panel (panel) to the air pollution control division in the department of public health and environment indefinitely. The panel is scheduled to repeal on September 1, 2026.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**  
3 (17)(a)(I) as follows:

4 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**  
5 **declaration - definition - repeal.**

6 (17) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated  
7 advisory committees will repeal on September 1, 2026:

8 (I) ~~The compliance advisory panel to the air pollution control~~  
9 ~~division created in section 25-7-109.2, C.R.S.;~~

10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-7-109.2, **amend**  
11 (6) as follows:

12 **25-7-109.2. Small business stationary source technical and**  
13 **environmental compliance assistance program - rules - advisory**  
14 **panel - legislative declaration.**

15 (6) The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this  
16 section is enacted for purposes of compliance with the provisions of  
17 section 507 of the federal act, 42 U.S.C. sec. 7661f. ~~Subsections (2), (3),~~  
18 ~~and (4) of this section and this subsection (6) are repealed, effective~~  
19 ~~September 1, 2026. Prior to said repeal, the compliance advisory panel~~  
20 ~~shall be reviewed by a legislative committee of reference, designated~~  
21 ~~pursuant to section 2-3-1201, C.R.S., to conduct the review pursuant to~~  
22 ~~section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.~~

23 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act

1 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
2 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
3 12, 2026, if adjournment sine die is on May 13, 2026); except that, if a  
4 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
5 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
6 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
7 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
8 November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
9 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
