Summary Information

Overview. The bill repeals the Veterinary Pharmaceutical Advisory Committee.

Types of impacts. The bill repeals a task force that is scheduled to repeal under current law; thus, the bill has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

Summary of Legislation

The bill repeals the Veterinary Pharmaceutical Advisory Committee on September 1, 2026, as recommended by the Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) in its [2025 sunset review of the advisory committee](#).

Background

The advisory committee is primarily responsible for reviewing disciplinary, licensing and rulemaking matters referred to it by the Pharmacy Board. The committee had no revenue or expenditures in FY 2023-24 or FY 2024-25. Created in 2016, the board has had no meetings since 2021.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill repeals an advisory committee that has been inactive since 2021 and has no revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
