1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** 25-1-136.

3 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**
4 (17)(a)(VI) as follows:

5 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**
6 **declaration - definition - repeal.**

7 (17) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated
8 advisory committees will repeal on September 1, 2026:

9 (VI) ~~The kidney disease prevention and education task force~~
10 ~~created in section 25-1-136;~~

11 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
12 takes effect September 1, 2026; except that, if a referendum petition is
13 filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against
14 this act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period
15 after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item,
16 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the
17 general election to be held in November 2026 and, in such case, will take
18 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the
19 governor.
