## **Summary of Legislation**

---

The bill requires a newspaper that publishes a legal notice to make the notice available on its website without charge.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

---

The bill does not reduce the number of notices required, and instead imposes requirements on newspapers. Because governments are still required to publish notices, the bill does not change state and local government revenue or expenditures. Therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Effective Date**

---

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
