A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING A CORRECTION TO A CITATION FOR BOND FORFEITURE**
102 **MONEY DEPOSITED IN THE JUDICIAL STABILIZATION CASH FUND.**

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill corrects a statutory reference related to depositing bond forfeiture money in the judicial stabilization cash fund.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 16-4-111, **amend** (7)
2 as follows:

3 **16-4-111. Disposition of security deposits upon forfeiture or**
4 **termination of bond.**

5 (7) ~~On and after July 1, 2008, all moneys~~ ALL MONEY collected
6 from payment toward a judgment entered for the state pursuant to
7 ~~paragraph (b) of subsection (1)~~ SUBSECTION (3) of this section shall be
8 transmitted to the state treasurer for deposit in the judicial stabilization
9 cash fund created in section 13-32-101 (6). ~~C.R.S.~~

10 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
12 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
13 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
14 institutions.
