SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 26-021

101 **CONCERNING DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF APRIL AS NATIONAL ARAB**
102 **AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH.**

1 WHEREAS, For over a century, Arab Americans have been
2 making valuable contributions to every aspect of American society: In
3 medicine, law, business, education, technology, government, military
4 service, and culture; and

5 WHEREAS, Since migrating to the United States, individuals of
6 Arab descent have shared their rich culture and traditions with neighbors
7 and friends, while also serving as fine examples of model citizens and
8 public servants; and

9 WHEREAS, Arab Americans have occupied all areas of industry,
10 such as: Lebanese-American Philip Hitti, who established the first

1 Department of Semitic Languages at Princeton University;
2 Egyptian-American Dr. Farouk El-Baz, who was instrumental in planning
3 the Apollo moon landings; Algerian-American Dr. Elias Zerhouni, who
4 was director of the National Institutes of Health in the 2000s; and
5 Iraqi-American Dr. Mona Hanna, whose research exposed the Flint Water
6 Crisis; and

7 WHEREAS, Arab migrants brought with them to the United States
8 their resilient family values, strong work ethic, dedication to education,
9 and diversity in faith and creed that have added strength to our great
10 democracy; and

11 WHEREAS, Arab Americans have enriched our society by sharing
12 in the entrepreneurial American spirit that makes our nation free and
13 prosperous; and

14 WHEREAS, The celebration of Arab American ancestry and
15 cultural heritage educates our fellow Americans and counters
16 misconceptions and harmful stereotyping; and

17 WHEREAS, Arab Americans join all Americans in their desire to
18 see a peaceful and diverse society, one in which every individual is
19 treated equally and feels safe; and

20 WHEREAS, On April 19, 2021, the White House issued a letter
21 recognizing the month of April as National Arab American Heritage
22 Month, the first recognition of this kind issued on a federal level; and

23 WHEREAS, In the United States, the Arab American community
24 is made up of approximately 3.7 million individuals, 42,000 of whom call
25 Colorado home; and

26 WHEREAS, Over 3,000 households in Denver county alone report
27 Arabic as their spoken language; and

28 WHEREAS, Colorado has been home to Arab Americans since the
29 late 19th century, with the first major wave of Arab Americans arriving
30 in the state between 1880 and 1890; and

31 WHEREAS, The incredible contributions and heritage of Arab
32 Americans have helped us build a better nation and state; now, therefore,

1 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-fifth General Assembly*
2 *of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:*

3 (1) That the General Assembly recognizes the contributions that
4 Arab Americans have made to the development of the United States and
5 the state of Colorado;

6 (2) That the General Assembly officially designates the month of
7 April as National Arab American Heritage Month, to be observed yearly
8 as a time dedicated to recognizing the valuable contributions of Arab
9 Americans; and

10 (3) That the General Assembly urges Colorado residents and
11 institutions to actively participate in this special observance.
