Fiscal Note Status

The most recent Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note (attached) reflects the fiscal impact of the bill as of 02/03/26.

No Change: Attached LCS Fiscal Note accurately reflects the fiscal impact of the bill.

The Senate Education Committee Report (02/09/26) and the House Education Committee Report (05/06/26) include amendments to the bill, however, Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the amendments do not change the fiscal impact of the bill.

The Senate Appropriations Committee Report (04/28/26) added a provision that: (1) requires receipt of \$500,000 in gifts, grants, and donations by September 1, 2027; (2) repeals the Council created in the bill if the threshold funding is not received by that date; and (3) requires return of any money received to donors and grantors if the threshold funding is not received in time.
