Summary Information

Overview. The bill repeals the Kidney Disease Prevention and Education Task Force.

No fiscal impact. The bill repeals a task force that is scheduled to repeal under current law; thus, the bill has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

Appropriations. No appropriation is required.

Summary of Legislation

The bill repeals the Kidney Disease Prevention and Education Task Force on September 1, 2026, as recommended by the Department of Regulatory Agencies in its [2025 sunset review](#).

Background

The task force is primarily responsible for working with policymakers, nonprofit organizations, and health care entities to increase awareness of kidney disease in Colorado. In FY 2024-25, it had General Fund expenditures of about \$95,000 from staff and facilitation costs, and revenue of about \$95,000 from gifts, grants, and donations. The task force is scheduled to submit its final report in August 2026.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

As this task force is already scheduled to repeal on September 1, 2026, the bill implements current law and thus, is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 20, 2026, and takes effect August 12, 2026, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
