CONCERNING CONTINUING THE MICROGRIDS FOR COMMUNITY RESILIENCE GRANT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 40-9.8-104, **amend** (5) introductory portion; and **repeal** (7) as follows:

40-9.8-104. Microgrids for community resilience grant program - creation - grant application process - report.

(5) ~~On or before December 1, 2023, and~~ NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), on or before December 1 of each year, ~~thereafter~~, the division shall submit a report summarizing the grants

awarded in the previous twelve months through the grant program, including:

(7) ~~This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2026.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for

the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state institutions.
